NATAS Lower Great Lakes Chapter Scholarship

The scholarship funded directly by our NATAS chapter members is offered to a student who attends school anywhere in the membership area of our organization which includes Cleveland, Akron, Canton, Youngstown, Bowling Green, Toledo, Lima, and Mansfield, Ohio; Erie, Pennsylvania; Indianapolis, Fort Wayne, Bloomington, Lafayette and Muncie, Indiana. The student must be attending college in our region to qualify. This scholarship goes to a student who will be a college junior or senior in the 2018-19 academic year and who intends to pursue a career in television or a television-related field.

Applications

The application process for the scholarship is done completely online through our website: nataslgl.org. On the site, hover over the "Students" tab at the top right of the page, and select "Scholarships" from the drop down menu. Students may then fill out the online application. **Online applications must be completed by midnight of February 28, 2018.**

Applications will be screened by our scholarship committee, and finalists will be notified in March. Finalists will be interviewed by members of the NATAS Lower Great Lakes Chapter scholarship selection committee.

The scholarship recipient and parents or guardians will receive complimentary tickets to the 49th Annual NATAS Lower Great Lakes Chapter Regional Emmy® Awards ceremony where the student will receive on-stage recognition. The gala is planned for Saturday, June 23, 2018 at Crane Bay in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Through our scholarship program, the Lower Great Lakes Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences is investing in the future of the television industry and promoting excellence in television, the mission of our organization.
