As in years past, the Lower Great Lakes Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (*the Emmy® Awards people*) will this year award a \$2,500 scholarship to a rising college junior or senior in the 2019-2020 academic year. The applicant must intend to pursue a career in television, or a television-related field.

NATAS Lower Great Lakes Chapter Scholarship

The scholarship is funded directly by our NATAS chapter members, and is offered to a student who attends school anywhere in the membership area of our organization which includes the television markets of Cleveland, Akron, Canton, Youngstown, Bowling Green, Toledo, Lima, and Mansfield, Ohio; Erie, Pennsylvania; Indianapolis, Fort Wayne, Bloomington, Lafayette and Muncie, Indiana. Again - students must be attending college in our region to qualify, but can hail from any state.

Applications

The application process for the scholarship must be completed online, through our website: www.NATASLG.org. Simply hover over the "Students" tab at the top right of the page, and select "Scholarships" from the drop-down menu. Students may then complete the online application.

Online applications must be completed by February 28, 2019.

Applications will be screened by our scholarship committee, and finalists will be notified in March. The finalists will be interviewed by members of the NATAS Lower Great Lakes Chapter scholarship selection committee.

The scholarship recipient, and parents or guardians, will receive complimentary tickets to the 50th Annual NATAS Lower Great Lakes Chapter Regional Emmy® Awards ceremony where the student will receive on-stage recognition. This year's gala is planned for Saturday, June 15, 2019 in the Grand Ballroom of the Renaissance Cleveland Hotel in Cleveland, Ohio.

Through our scholarship program, the Lower Great Lakes Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences is investing in the future of the television industry and promoting excellence in television, the mission of our organization.
